

# March 2008 Youth Art Month Exhibit Requirements

1. **Read** these guidelines to help you to prepare for the exhibit.
2. **Return** the registration form on the next page by **Friday, February 15, 2008** or  
**REGISTER ONLINE AND DOWNLOAD ADDITIONAL FORMS and LABELS AT:**

3. **Complete and bring** the **yellow inventory form** with your artwork to the Worcester Art Museum on Tuesday, February 26th, 3:00-5:00, 2008 / (snow date Wednesday, February 27th, 2008).

**ENTRY LIMIT:** **3 PIECES** of student artwork (**different lessons**) per teacher who is a **non-member of MAEA/NAEA.**  
**5 PIECES** of student artwork (**different lessons**) per teacher who is a **member of MAEA/NAEA.** All artwork must be original. No group work will be allowed.

**SIZE LIMIT:** **No bigger than 22" x 28" (including mat).**

Pedestals are available for small 3D projects. Please vary the sizes . we cannot all bring in huge pieces! One large piece per customer is a good rule of thumb!

**LABELS:** Student identification labels must be **TYPED** using the attached labels or similar format on the computer. Affix labels neatly (no staples) to the **lower right front corner.**

**PRINT ON THE BACK OF EACH PIECE:** Student's Name, Grade Level, School's Name, City/Town, Teacher's Name and Phone #.

**ALL ARTWORK MUST BE MATTED – NOT MOUNTED.** Avoid heavyweight or thick backing on mats. Traditional **white mats only!** No staples! No glass!!! **YAM/WAM is not responsible for damaged artwork – please make sure things are well matted – poorly taped items tend to fall and get stepped on!**

## **Presentation Quality is Expected!**

**Artwork that is not matted within a white mat and properly labeled will be rejected.**  
**Do not tell the students that their pieces will be at the Worcester Art Museum until the committee has formally accepted the pieces. Artwork must be hand-delivered with completed inventory list and shown for acceptance or it will be rejected.**

- DROP-OFF DATE:** Tuesday, February 26th, 2008 from 3:00-5:00PM  
(Snow Date: Wednesday, February 27th, 2008 from 3:00-5:00PM)  
We must stick to the 3-5 PM time frame!
- DROP-OFF LOCATION:** The Worcester Art Museum, Higgins Education Wing,  
Use the Lancaster Street Entrance.
- OPENING RECEPTION:** Sunday, March 9, 2008, 1:00-4:00PM (No snow dates)
- TEEN NIGHT:** Thursday, March 13, 2008, 5:30-8:00PM (No snow dates)
- PICK-UP DATE:** Tuesday, April 1, 2008, 3:00-5:00PM (Snow Date: Wednesday, April 2, 3-5PM)

**\*YAM Committee and the Worcester Art Museum are not responsible for artwork that is not picked up during this day/time frame. You are responsible for picking up your students' artwork during this time!**
